ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

This Acceptable Use Policy (the “Policy”) lists acceptable and unacceptable uses of our Services. If you use our Services, you agree to this Policy. If you don’t agree with this Policy, do not use our Services.

“Services” means our products and services including but not limited to our websites and services, whether public or login-protected. This includes, but is not limited to, our public websites; donation forms; mobile SDKs; our APIs; our management tools for nonprofits, brands, donors; and our back-end services for donation collection and donation payment.

Violations of this Policy may result in the suspension or termination of your access to the Services. If you have an Account or Subscribers, they may also be suspended or terminated. Violations of this policy may also result in legal action. In addition, the user may be required to pay for the costs of investigation and remedial action related to Policy violations. We reserve the right to take any other remedial action we see fit.

Acceptable and Unacceptable Uses

- Do not issue fraudulent offers to sell or buy products, services, or investments.
- Do not impersonate another person or entity or misrepresent your affiliation with any person, organization, or entity.
- Do not commit fraud in any other way.

If you have an Account (a credential or login to access the Service):

- Use commercially reasonable efforts to prevent unauthorized access to the Service, including protecting the confidentiality of your login credentials.
- Do not allow any unauthorized person or entity to access the Service, your Account, or any associated Authorized User’s accounts. Do not provide logins or other credentials to any third party.
- Do not share Accounts or Subscriptions.
- Do not hack or damage our systems.
